



Thank you, for your purchase of a Fortec Star **STATIONARY** Satellite system. Once you have set up your system you will be able to enjoy many hours of FREE Satellite broadcasting from around the world. **There are 3 simple steps to follow.** To get started take your information card supplied and go to our website and find the technical support page at:

Many years of experience have gone into all our self-help guides and may be different from the printed material that comes with the individual parts in your order, follow this guide.

FIRST we recommend you read “[Tips and Tricks](#)” You will need a good compass.

SECOND follow the guide called “[Aiming Stationary Dish](#)”. If you cannot find your location in the first section you can enter your zip code in the 3rd section to get your latitude and longitude. Go back to the first section. In the first box, select the satellite you wish to aim at (example: IA-5 at 97w), put in your own latitude and longitude (example 43.1 and 88.2) in the other box and click the calculate bar to get the settings you will need for that satellite. [These will show up in the second section]. **MAKE SURE TO WRITE THE SETTINGS ON YOUR CARD.**

One final calculation is left. You must add or subtract the “magnetic declination from your azimuth to find your true heading. To do so, find your location on the map. What line are you closest to? (Example +7 for Ohio, -16 for Washington).

NOW YOU CAN AIM YOUR DISH !

THIRD go to the “[Receiver Installation Tip](#)” link and fine tune your settings to get the strongest signal for your area.
